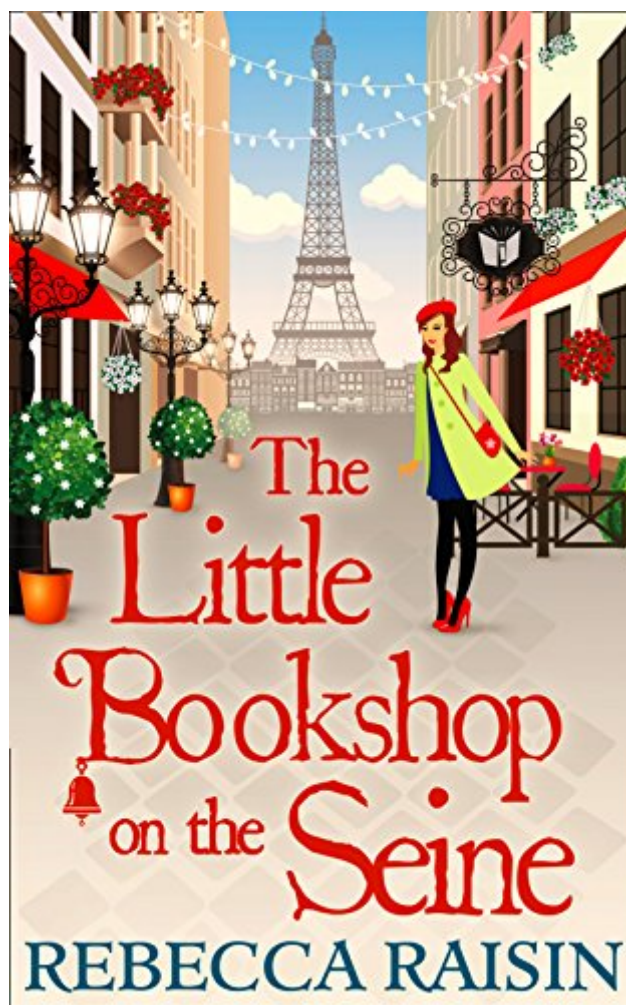

It's located right along the Seine and is in a perfect location. Sarah and Sophie have become friends via a bookshop blog and Skype quite often. So, when Sophie's heart is broken by her boyfriend, she suggests to Sarah that they exchange working at each other's bookshops for a period of time as Sophie needs to get away. Living in Paris has always been on Sarah's bucket list and so she agrees. They will live in each other's apartments so it all works out perfectly. When Sarah arrives in Paris, she is thrown right into the bookstore and becomes fascinated with the numerous customers and vast size of the store itself. Excited about being in Paris, she finds herself constantly tied to the store juggling all of the customers and endless duties.
