I picked up this book because I occasionally like to read thrillers/mysteries as a break from the typical type of book that I read - which is chick lit books. The premise of this book seemed interesting- an agoraphobic woman starts watching her new dysfunctional neighbors across the

street and begins to fear for the safety of the 13 year old daughter. To make it more interesting, the author decided to tell the story from the perspective of not just the agoraphobic Hannah, but from the mother, Sarah and daughter, April as well. Some of the reviews are a bit cautious about this book. They, rightly, say that the book would be more intense if it was told only from the perspective of Hannah. And it would have been more intense. But I would say this book is more than just a thriller, it is also a story about women stuck in their lives, not moving forward and not being healthy, held captive in lives they created because of the trauma they suffered as children. As the events of this book unfold, both Hannah and Sarah are forced to confront their individual pasts in order to move through the horror unfolding before them. This book started about a bit slow, but picked up the pace and was actually good read. It did not drag itself out for a long time or have multiple twists that went nowhere. This book builds and tells a story the unfolds over a relatively short period of time. I would say that if you have read the description of the book and are a bit interested in the story but not sure if you should read it, go ahead and give it a try. I liked it.I also think this could make a great book club choice. Like I said above, it is not a straight thriller. Although I am not in book club right now, I would recommend this book if I was.
