When reading Kafka, there is an overwhelming darkness, loneliness, a strong shadow that continually hovered around him, a "something" he tried to rid himself of through intense self reflection, which the reader of these diaries will discover. Kafka's life story is, for the most part, a tragedy. A painful experience as one, sometimes, can feel his self
